Greetings, Certain Sundays throughout the liturgical year have taken their names from the first word in Latin of the entrance antiphon. This Sunday's antiphon is "rejoice in the Lord always." Gaudete (meaning "rejoice" in Latin) Sunday is a joyous celebration. Although it takes place during the usually penitential period of Advent, Gaudete Sunday serves as a midpoint break to rejoice in the nearness of Jesus's return.
